Central hospital bargaining negotiations hit an impasse on Thursday after it has become clear the Ontario Hospital Association (OHA) is making no effort to come to a deal. Throughout the week, SEIU was very optimistic that we could reach an agreement. But the OHA does not seem to have any intention of negotiating a settlement before the election on October 6.

In response, SEIU has filed charges against the OHA for bargaining in bad faith. Your union also protested in front of the OHA's downtown office in Toronto.

SEIU's bargaining team has done an excellent job bargaining with the OHA. SEIU members should be proud of the bargaining committee's efforts and accomplishments. But we all know the old saying - **"It takes 2 to tango."**
